

Student Scholarships – Minnesota Chapter of The Wildlife Society

The Minnesota Chapter of the Wildlife Society has established two Fedeler Scholarships in memory of past president Bob Fedeler, who taught in the Natural Resources Department at Central Lakes College in Brainerd. These scholarships consist of two awards (one undergraduate student, one graduate student) of full membership in The Wildlife Society including all publications of The Wildlife Society.

The Fedeler Scholarships help beginning wildlife professionals get started with membership in The Wildlife Society and expose them to research and issues discussions through the Society's various publications.

Students applying for the Fedeler Scholarships should be undergraduates in their junior or senior year or graduate students in a masters or doctorate program at a Minnesota college or University. They should

- Have a 3.0 or better GPA
- Have a strong interest in a career in wildlife biology
- Be active in extracurricular activities
- Have a strong sense of public service
- Have demonstrated good communication skills.

To apply, students should

- Send a letter indicating interest and explain how you meet the requirements to the Minnesota Chapter Membership Chair at the address below
- Ask your academic or research advisor to send a letter of recommendation to the same address

Application Deadline is determined each year, usually ~15 January. Consult the previous calendar year's December Newsletter (<http://www.crk.umn.edu/TWS/MN/newsletter.html>).

The awards will be presented to winning applicants at the MN TWS annual meeting in February.
